

COVID-19 Info Sheet

To attend the ICLConference21, you are required to comply with the 2,5G rule (tested, vaccinated, recovered). *



Tested:

Only PCR test results (valid for 48 hours) are accepted. Proof of negative test can be a doctor's certificate or an official test result.



Vaccinated:

You are considered vaccinated:

- If you have received both doses of Comirnaty/ Pfizer, Spikevax/Moderna, Vaxzevria/ AstraZeneca;
- Starting on the 22nd day after your single Janssen/ Johnson & Johnson; or
- If you had a COVID infection and have received one vaccination dose (proof of past infection required).

Accepted vaccines: All vaccines accepted by the EMA (Comirnaty/ Pfizer, Spikevax/Moderna, Vaxzevria/ AstraZeneca, Janssen/ Johnson & Johnson)

Accepted proofs of vaccination:

- Yellow vaccination record
- Vaccination card/passport/certificate
- EU Green pass
- Print-out of the data in the electronic vaccination record



Recovered:

- Recovered from an infection within the past 180 days

Accepted types of evidence include:

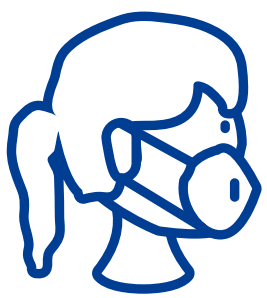
- Antibody tests (not older than 3 months), or
- An official/medical certificate proving past infection

*Please note that these regulations may still change by the time of the conference, according to the measures announced by Austrian authorities. We will keep you informed regarding any new provisions.

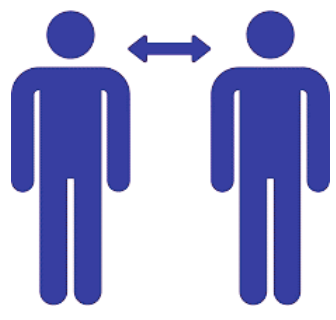
Safe behaviours:



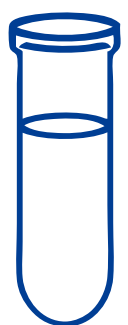
Wash and disinfect hands frequently, for at least 20 seconds
